Detpak's update on Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) in fibre-based food contact packaging in Australia

In response to the growing awareness of PFAS as chemicals of concern, and the Australian Packaging Covenant Organization's (APCO) 'Action Plan to Phase Out PFAS in Fibre-Based Food Contact Packaging' (linked), Detpak has been working to remove added PFAS from our full range of fibre-based food contact packaging.

Extensive testing has been completed across our range of fibre-based materials to determine which materials and products would be classified as having intentionally added PFAS¹, as indicated by levels of fluorine above 100 parts per million (ppm). Through a substantial review of our supply chain, the only materials and products which we identified to contain added PFAS are our grease resistant papers, such as those used in fry bags, and our moulded fibre products, such as those made from sugarcane bagasse.

Detpak are now in the process of replacing these products by transitioning these materials within our supply chain into some of the best quality PFAS Free² grease resistant papers and moulded fibre products available on the market.

As an example, we recently launched the Vanguard® range from Eco-Products® which are a range of sugarcane bagasse products with no intentionally added PFAS. We have also begun sourcing and producing PFAS Free² grease resistant paper bags and wraps, and are aiming to transition the remaining intentionally added PFAS items out of our Australian supply chain over the coming months in line with APCO's suggested PFAS Action Plan timeline.
